Dear Friends and Clients,

Now is the time to get ready for spring. One of the most important things to do is make sure your pets are protected against **Heartworm, Fleas, and Ticks**.

For our cats, we are using a topical product called Revolution. This should be applied to the skin between the shoulders once monthly beginning May 1st or June 1st through November. If you already have the Revolution please start May 1st. If you need to pick some up please give us a call at the number above and we will be happy to get it ready for you.

For our dogs, we will no longer offer the topical Revolution. They should now be on Interceptor once monthly, preferably year round for heartworm and intestinal parasite control. If your dog is an outdoor enthusiast then you need to apply Frontline topically on their skin between their shoulders once monthly for "**Flea and Tick**" control. Tick control is becoming more of an importance in Grand Traverse County due to the "Deer tick" that has moved into our area. If you have your Frontline begin using it May 1st. If you need to pick your Frontline or Interceptor up please give us a call in advance so we can make sure it is ready for you.

If you have any questions regarding this upcoming Flea, Tick, and Heartworm season please feel free to call us and we will be happy to answer any of your questions. We look forward to hearing from you soon. Together we can keep our furry friends safe this summer.
